### **Overview**

- Donor: European Commission, Research Executive Agency (REA)
- Objective: To develop and test a suitable structure to select and fund researchers (PhD-doctoral students / Post-Doc) at risk at EU higher education and research institutions
- Target groups:
  - Track 1: At-risk researchers currently outside the EU (no refugee/protection status)
  - Track 2: At-risk researchers already within the EU (refugee/protection/temporary status)
- Consortium: DAAD, Campus France, PAUSE (hosted by Collège de France), UNIMED + associated partners
- Budget: 12 Mio. EUR; up to 60 fellowships
- Implementation Period: 36 months as of September 2024





### **SAFE Activities**

- Overall project coordination (DAAD)
- Communication & networking activities (Campus France)
- Provision of matchmaking services (UNIMED)
- Design and implementation of selection mechanism (DAAD)
- Fellowship management (Campus France)
- Capitalisation (PAUSE)





# **Fellowship value**

#### Researchers:

- Doctoral/PhD students: 3400 EUR + 600 EUR mobility monthly
- Postdocs: 5080 EUR + 600 EUR mobility monthly
- Possibility for special needs allowance

#### Host institutions:

- 1000 EUR monthly contribution to research training and networking
- 650 EUR for management and indirect contribution

# **Application requirements**

- Prospective host institution to apply on behalf of the researcher
- Eligible host institutions are academic or non-academic higher education and/or research organisations established in an EU Member State
- One application per institution only, on behalf of one researcher
- Host institution = legal entity as a whole (e.g. whole university rather than the individual institutes and/or departments)
- Application must be endorsed by the head of the institution
- Open to all disciplines





# **Eligibility & selection criteria**

#### **Eligibility criteria for researchers:**

- (1) Candidates must be
- a. Doctoral/PhD candidates\*
- b. Postdoctoral researchers\*
- (2) Candidates must have the necessary language skills to successfully conduct their research project
- (3) Candidates must not hold EU citizenship
- (4) Candidates must face or have faced qualifying risks

#### Selection criteria:

- "Excellence"
- "Implementation"
- "Impact"

Eligibility and risk questionnaire available on the website as a check tool prior to the application


# **Application process: Online Platform and documents**

- Submission of applications on application platform until 20th January 2025, at 23:59 (CET).
- Link to the application portal available here: Online Application SAFE
- Documents to be submitted according to selection criteria
  - (0) General documents
  - (1) Excellence
  - (2) Implementation
  - (3) Impact
- For certain documents, forms are provided on the above website & required
- Detailed information on application documents in the Terms of References for Applicants & application checklists on the website
- Important exception: External assessment letter to be submitted via <a href="mailto:review.safe@daad.de">review.safe@daad.de</a>





# **Application process**



#### Head of host institution

- Must endorse the application
- Must sign the hosting plan
- Contact details to be provided during the application

#### Responsible contact person at the host institution

- Must be identified during the application
- Must be employed by the host institution
- Will serve as main contact point during the selection process

# **Matchmaking overview**


- Optional service to connect researchers at risk with EU-based host institutions to codevelop proposals for the SAFE fellowship call
- Timeline: mid-October to mid-December 2024
- Key Benefits:
  - for researchers: matches at-risk researchers with suitable EU hosts, opening pathways for SAFE proposals
  - for host institutions: helps identify researchers aligned with institutional expertise and goals
- Data privacy:
  - Managed in full compliance with EU data protection laws
  - Access is restricted to authorised users via secure login
  - Information is used solely for SAFE matchmaking
