EU funding acknowledgment and disclaimer

Fellows and Host Institutions are encouraged to communicate about their research projects. To comply with EU rules in external communications, the European Commission provides useful tips:

Please note that the EU funding acknowledgement containing a disclaimer is required by the EU, not only when publishing but also when communicating about your project.

Two options are possible to include this:

Option 1:
